Entrance requirements: Students must meet and maintain the School of Nursing minimum GPA requirement of 2.50 for the Pre Nursing major. https://www.unlv.edu/nursing/admissions

Minimum Requirements For Application:

1. Must have a current RN license in U.S. state/territory or locale where student will complete clinical requirements.
2. Completion of all prerequisite courses or enrollment of last remaining prerequisite courses listed on Pre-Nursing worksheet.
3. A minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA is required to apply to the Nursing program. If no UNLV GPA has been earned then the cumulative GPA from all other schools attended will be used.
4. A minimum "B or higher" within two (2) attempts is required for MATH 120 or higher, BIOL 223, BIOL 224, BIOL 251, and NURS 299. Withdraws "W" and Audits "AD" count as attempts.
5. A minimum "C or higher" is required for all other courses listed. Complete the HESI A2 Entry Exam with a minimum 75% or higher in all subject areas within two (2) attempts (Anatomy & Physiology, Grammar, Reading Comprehensive, Math)
6. A review of your prerequisite courses must be completed by an academic advisor prior to confirm eligibility. Call (702) 895-5448 to schedule an appointment.
7. HESI A2 Entry Exam is waived based on previous nursing degree.

Note: Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee entrance into the School of Nursing BSN program.

Application Process Once Min. Requirements Are Met:

1. An application into the Nursing program is required.
2. Must have an Associate Degree in Nursing.
3. The **HESI A2 Entry Exam** is waived based on previous nursing degree.
4. Thirty (30) upper division credits are earned for portfolio courses: Letter of intent, supervisor letter, copy of RN license and resume. Required: \$225.00 fee for portfolio processing and transcript review (this is subject to change without notice). Portfolio review is done the first semester of the RN-BSN Program.
5. Students must apply to one of the following entry terms using the deadlines below:
 - November 1-February 1 for Summer admission
 - February 1-May 1 for Fall admission
6. Students are ranked on a point system by a calculation worksheet.
7. Students **must** have completed **50 or more credits** of PRN prerequisites at UNLV to receive **Rebel Recognition** 1/2 point.
8. **Top 72** students are selected every term based off the total points received on the calculation worksheet. **88 points minimum** to apply.
9. These 72 students will be accepted into School of Nursing BSN program which will begin the following semester.
10. Once admitted into the BSN program, students will be considered Nursing majors and the designation will change from PRN to NURS.
11. RN-BSN Nursing students will complete additional 30 credits of the full major RN-BSN program (2 semesters).
